## Exam + Multifocal Glasses

- Who is this for:
  - Anyone whose eyes have <u>lost</u> the ability to change focus between near and far objects
  - $\circ$  Most commonly for those <u>over</u> the age of 40
  - Anyone finding the need for readers or has been recommended or prescribed a bifocal, Trifocal, or Progressive Addition Lens
- Included Services and materials
